

Constitutional amendment to facilitate voting procedure changes

1. *To change the concept of an ordinary majority.* The definition area of the constitution defines an ordinary majority in relation to a members meeting to be **more than 50% of the total number of votes**. We recommend that the next AGM consider the ‘plurality’ concept of voting requiring an amendment to this definition to delete this passage and be replaced by “the largest number of votes received “. Item 14.4 to be amended to exclude the word “majority and following passage” and include “the largest number of votes by rank sufficient to elect all available positions that are required to be filled”. Item 20.1 to be amended to exclude “majority” and include “largest ranking”.
